

RLabs named Social Innovator of the Year 2022

The Schwab Foundation for Social Entrepreneurship announced 15 leaders in social innovation as the 2022 awardees. Marlon Parker, cofounder, and Rene Parker the CEO of Reconstructed Living Lab (RLabs) from South Africa were awarded the Social Innovators Award.

This prestigious award is in recognition of the RLabs model that has grown from a Cape Town community project helping underserved communities into a global social enterprise that has helped more 20 million people across 23 countries through offering technology skills training, building new social innovations and creating economic empowerment opportunities.

The awardees were selected by Schwab Foundation Board members, including Helle Thorning-Schmidt, Prime Minister of Denmark (2011-2015), and social innovation expert Johanna Mair, Professor of Organisation, Strategy and Leadership at the Hertie School of Governance in Germany, and Queen Mathilde of Belgium (Honorary Board Member), in recognition of their innovative approach and potential for global impact.
