The final blow: State Capture Commission report reveals gaps in Ramaphosa's testimony

The final report of the State Capture Commission has now been released.

This follows the Zondo Commission's completion of its four-year inquiry, handing over the final report and recommendations to the president on Wednesday night.

Among the <u>findings</u> of the report are that President Cyril Ramaphosa lied when questioned on the work of the review panel on the State Security Agency.

It was also <u>uncovered</u> that Jacob Zuma abused power and that Ramaphosa often let him do so.

Public demand for parts V and VI of the report is currently so high that the Presidency website is being affected by high volumes of visitors to the site.
