The Mary Fitzgerald Square in Newtown will host the City of Johannesburg's Public Viewing Area (PVA) for the World Cup from 11 June to 11 July 2010. The PVA will hire exhibition, retail and food stalls at the event, in varying budget categories, to entertain the anticipated 200 000 visitors who will watch the soccer matches on big screens.
