


Acumen Media's weekly news roundup

Let's take a look at Acumen Media's seven-day analysis of the news making headlines in South Africa. Following the inauguration of the country's fifth democratically-elected president, Cyril Ramaphosa's cabinet announcement - which included some surprises - was on everyone's minds.

Good leader Patricia de Lille and Pravin Gordhan's inclusion in the cabinet was one of the biggest stories relating to the cabinet announcement. Gordhan also dominated other news as the Public Protector released her report on the former finance minister.
