

Rapper Costa Titch collapses on stage, dies

South African rapper Costa Titch, whose real name is Costa Tsobanoglou, has died. According to reports, the 28 years old collapsed on stage during his performance at the Ultra Music Festival at the Nasrec Expo Centre on Saturday, 11 March.

His death comes just a month after another rapper Kiernan Forbes famously known as AKA was shot dead on Durban.
