I'm sure he will prove to be a great asset to 94.7 and will fit well into the format. At this point, he is still a freelancer and nothing is permanent. He will be filling in for various presenters, when necessary, while they are on leave".

During his illustrious career, Jay joined 702 as a late-night DJ in 1983 and moved to the afternoon drive show a year later. He joined the national music station, Radio 5 in 1986, hosting the breakfast show for nearly 8 years. Alex left the SABC in October 2002.
