

New programme manager and lineup changes for OFM

Tim Zunckel, breakfast show host on Radio 2000 and owner of the Tim Zunckel Radio Consultancy has been appointed new programme manager at OFM from 1 July 2008. He will be replacing Shana Kilbee, who will be relocating to England.

- Lindsay Batteson, co-host of the Sound Xpress, will continue with the show on weekdays from 21:00 24:00 on her own.
