Those that got all three correct when the competition closed on 13 February would be in line to win the R2,000 prize (two winners in each region).

"We are also celebrating the fact that, having recently acquired a transmitter in Glencoe, we now broadcast to Newcastle, Dannhauser, Dundee, Osizweni and surrounding areas. We have promised to meet the high expectations of our new listeners - and we boldly say that we are targeting two million listeners in 2014!" she added.
