

It's back-to-school time with Gagasi FM

The selection process has already started with the applicants that have been selected thus being announced daily on I Love Mornings and Teatime to Lunchtime for learners as well as on The Big Bang and Afternoon Show Off for students.

The station's flagship campaign is targeted at well performing learners and students who are coming from underprivileged and disadvantaged family backgrounds. Listeners are encouraged to send their academic report from 2014, along with a motivational letter telling Gagasi why they need assistance.
