Algoa FM presenter Wayne Hart is in line for three out of seven 2015 MTN Radio Awards, for which the station has been nominated.



Hart, who presents the *Algoa FM Top 30*, received the 2013 MTN Radio Award for the Best Music show in South Africa. He was again nominated in 2014.

The *Algoa FM Top 30*, which is broadcast on Saturdays from 9am to noon has just been nominated for Best Weekend Show. He is also a nominee in the category of Best Afternoon Drive Show Presenter.

The Fast Lane, which he co-presents with Lauren Mungur, has been nominated in the Best Daytime Show category.

The 2013 winner of the Best Breakfast Show Presenter Award, Daron Mann, has again been nominated in this category.
