ABBA was a Swedish pop group formed in Stockholm in 1972 by Agnetha Fältskog, Björn Ulvaeus, Benny Andersson and Anni-Frid Lyngstad. They became one of the most commercially successful acts in the history of popular music, topping the charts worldwide from 1974 to 1982.

Several films, including *Muriel's Wedding* and *The Adventures of Priscilla, Queen of the Desert* featured ABBA's music in their soundtracks. The musical *Mamma Mia!*, inspired by the music of ABBA, was released in 2008 and became the highest-grossing film in the UK that year. A sequel, *Mamma Mia! Here We Go Again*, was released in 2018.

They've released countless hits, including *Mamma Mia*, *Thank You For The Music*, *Dancing Queen*, *Waterloo*, *Chiquitita* and many, many more.
