Shelley Steel has been appointed general manager of Courtyard Hotel Sandton, from her previous position as general manager of Town Lodge Midrand. as executive chef, Maistry will oversee Courtyard Hotel Waterfall City's two restaurants – the Protea Restaurant, which serves breakfast, lunch and dinner and the Highline Restaurant, which serves light meals for lunch and dinner; the six-seater Pincushion Boardroom; three event areas – Skyrocket, Sugarbush, Mountain Rose – catering for conferencing and banqueting of 40 people each or combined for 120 people; as well as room service.
