The school caters for 2000 learners from Grade R to 12. Officially registered in 2001, the school's mission is to mould learners into diligent, responsible, tolerant, knowledgeable, and accountable individuals who can confidently participate in the global society.

Adopt-a-School has been working with Diepsloot Combined School since 2006. The Foundation, through its partners, has implemented various projects at the school, including support of the Thari Programme, a project of the Cyril Ramaphosa Foundation that focuses on women and children.
