Each ticket includes the presentation about foraging and mushroom varieties, which covers those to be avoided and those that are edible; the forage excursion into Delheim's forest; and, a three-course, mushroom-inspired lunch served with wines from the estate.

The Delheim Wild Mushroom Forage is popular for the forest where the toadstools sprout. It is here that the fungus thrives undisturbed, weaving its threads beneath the forest floor, transforming organic matter into healthy soil.
