

Ethiopian signs code share agreement with Asiana Airlines

Ethiopian Airlines, reputed to be the fastest growing African airline, has signed a code share agreement with Asiana Airlines, the award-winning South Korean airline, enhancing the growing cooperation with Star Alliance member carriers.
