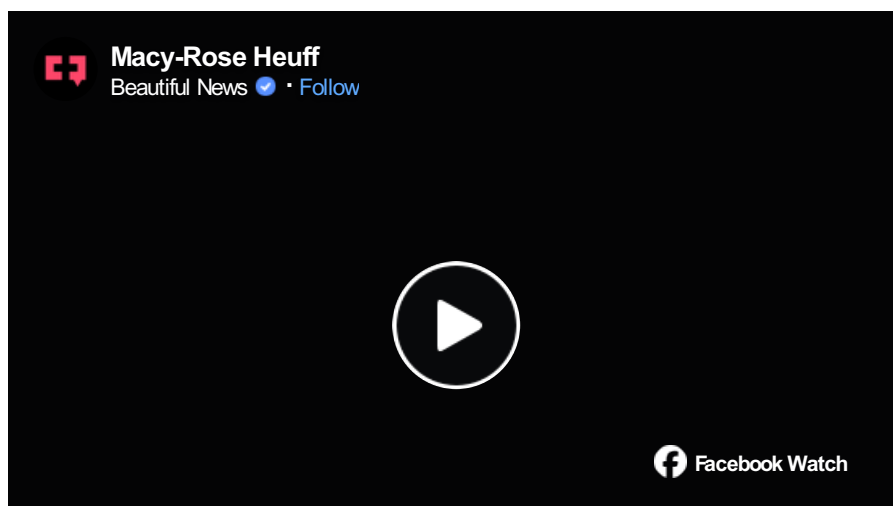


#BeautifulNews: The eight-year-old violinist carrying courage on her shoulder
