But when Hendricks ran onto the field, pictures of her were taken and posted to social media. Instantly, they went viral. Hendricks' amendments to her kit had caught onlookers off-guard. For protection and as a symbol of modesty, Muslim women veil their hair. Because of it, they're often doubly painted with the stigma of being oppressed. "That's not true," Hendricks says. "I am free."
